A few years later, in a small group of activists in Georgia, both black and white, began searching for ways to engrave the memory of the lynching on to the history of Walton County. Mourners file past the caskets of World War II veteran George Dorsey and his sister, Dorothy Dorsey Malcolm, days after they and two other The Lynching of Malcolm Brown sharecroppers were pulled from a car in rural north Georgia and killed on July 25, The judge ruled in accordance with precedent, that the testimony was of broad public interest and presented no threat to suspects and grand jurors, all of whom are thought to be dead.

There has been no prominent public memorial or monument to the thousands of blacks. I wrote this story in memory of my father. News of the deed spread almost instantly through the entire county by word of mouth, searing the threat of extrajudicial violence into the consciousness of all who heard about it.
