

**REGAINING YOUR COMMON SENSE - ALCOHOL ABUSE
AND DRUG USE: A GUIDE FOR THE FAMILY**

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Drug abuse may start as a way to socially connect. While education level is influential, it may be a reflection of other client characteristics or socioeconomic conditions. Akin to other services, smoking cessation programs should be integrated into substance abuse treatment for women. A comprehensive treatment plan may include: pharmacological treatment. It At an inpatient facility, clients participate in individual therapy sessions, group counseling, family therapy, support groups, and other activities that will help them learn how to avoid alcohol and drugs in the future. In a study examining variables associated with retention in outpatient services, women younger than 21 were not as likely to successfully complete outpatient treatment Scott-Lennox et al. More research is needed in evaluating outcome and the role of PTSD and relapse parents often infringe on the emotional boundaries that allow children to develop independently, turning the child into an expert caretaker who lacks social skills or a sense of personal identity. Denial is common in substance abuse.
